

94.7 WCSX People Helping People Nomination Guidelines

1. HOW TO NOMINATE

- (i) To nominate online, visit www.wcsx.com and follow the links and instructions to complete and submit the online nomination form beginning at 6:00am Eastern Time (“ET”) on Monday, November 11, 2019 and ending at 10:00 am ET on Friday, November 29, 2019. Nominators are subject to all notices posted online including but not limited to the Station's Privacy Policy. Limit one (1) nomination per eligible person. Nominations submitted may not be acknowledged or returned. All nominations must be received by 10:00 am ET on Friday, November 29, 2019.
- (ii) Each online nomination form must include the nominator’s first name, last name, address, city, state and telephone number, the first name, last name and contact information of the person being nominated (the “Nominee”), if different from the nominator, and an essay not to exceed one hundred (100) words explaining why the Nominee deserves to be helped and describing the Nominee’s needs such as clothes or toys for kids, help fixing a car, furniture, appliances etc. (“Essay Submission”). **By submitting an Essay Submission, nominator is confirming they have received permission from Nominee to be mentioned in the Essay Submission.**
- (iii) Any Essay Submission that exceeds one hundred (100) words will be edited by the Station to include only the first one hundred (100) words prior to posting. Each Essay Submission must be the nominator’s original creative work and must not be protected by copyright; each nominator must have the right to submit it. Station, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to edit any Essay Submission to preserve confidentiality and further reserves the right to disqualify any Essay Submission if such is inappropriate or unsuitable for public display, broadcast, or posting on the Station’s website (i.e., must be radio clean). Essay Submissions that do not comply will not be eligible.
- (iv) All Essay Submissions will be posted on the web page located at www.wcsx.com. The Nominee’s name and any personal information included in the Essay Submission will be removed or hidden before posting on the web page. Station personalities, including Jim & Erin from Big Jim’s House, will announce that listeners and local business can visit the People Helping People web page located at www.wcsx.com and offer their own assistance to a Nominee by notifying the Station of their intent to help.
- (v) When a listener and/or local business notifies the Station that they have chosen an Essay Submission/Nominee to help, the web page will include a notation that the Essay Submission/Nominee has been selected by a listener and/or local business. **There is no guarantee to the Nominee that any assistance will be provided and no guarantee of the value of the assistance offered. The last day Essay**

Submissions will be posted on the Station web page is November 29, 2019.

- (vi) The Station will use commercially-reasonable efforts to provide contact information to each party and to facilitate assistance between the Nominee and listener and/or local business. The Station will not be providing any contact information or facilitating any further assistance after Friday December 13, 2019.

2. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS

- (i) Open to all Station listeners who are 18 years of age or older as of the date of submission, who are legal US residents and reside in the Detroit metro survey area (as defined by Nielsen Audio), except where prohibited by law. Nominators and Nominees must possess a valid, government-issued ID. Nominators and Nominees must show proof of Detroit metro survey area (as defined by Nielsen Audio) residency to verify eligibility.
- (ii) Employees (including their immediate families and members of the same household) of Beasley Media Group, its affiliates and sponsors, advertising and promotional agencies who do business with 94.7 WCSX or any of the event sponsors, and other radio stations in the Detroit metro survey area are not eligible to participate. The term “immediate family” includes spouses, siblings, parents and legal guardians, children and legal wards, grandparents, and grandchildren, including “in-laws.”
